WATTS CEMETERY

Criteria for Burial/Interment

At present, only those people who live in Compton at the time of their death are eligible to be buried in a new grave, unless they previously purchased a plot whilst living in the parish.

Only residents of Compton are eligible to purchase a plot.

Applicants from outside the parish may have their ashes interred in an existing family grave (or, if the grave is a double one, a spouse living outside the parish may be buried in the grave).

Ashes may be scattered, in the ash scattering area near zone 5, by any applicant, upon payment of a fee.

Proposed new criteria:

- Recently resided in Compton (decide on time frame)
- Has a relative buried at Watts Cemetery
- Has made a significant contribution to village life, in voluntary capacity.
- Has made a significant contribution to the Chapel / Cemetery
- Has a connection to the Wattses (would have to exclude being a volunteer or employee of WG unless they fulfilled one of the above, due to the volume and transience of employees).
